Teams should have 2 robots in the field, one is a defender while the other is a striker. Wires should be kept above 30 cm from ground. Goalkeeper/Defender has to stay behind the center line (in their half), crossing which, would lead to a foul. Holding and trapping of ball is not allowed, if a robot holds the ball for more than 4 seconds, it will be counted as a foul. In case of technical issue in robot while match, no time would be given to rectify it until half time.

Details-

The "Robo War" event is a thrilling robotics competition where student-designed robots will compete in a wrestling or boxing match. This event encourages creativity, problem-solving, and teamwork among students, offering them a platform to display their technological prowess.

Categories:

- 1. Wrestling Bots: Robots designed to grapple and outmaneuver their opponents to win.
- 2. Boxing Bots: Robots equipped to punch and knock out their opponents.

Rules and Regulations:

- · Robots must be built by students.
- Robots should not be taller than 1.5 feet and must weigh less than 5 kg.
- Each match will last for a maximum of 3 minutes.
- Points will be awarded for successful maneuvers, including takedowns in wrestling and punches in boxing.

Violation of any rule will lead to immediate disqualification.
